TOURNAMENT RULES

- ◆ The Tournament shall be played in accordance with the rules of golf as laid down by The Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St Andrews, together with the local rules in force.
- ◆ All strokes must be played LEFT-HANDED (except trouble shots), tap in putts from no more than 10 centimetres also allowed without penalty.
- ◆ The term Left-handed Golfer is a player who plays their shots from a left-handed stance, their right hip facing the hole.

- ◆ The Tournament is to be contested over 4 championship rounds of stroke play.
- ◆ In the event of a tie for a championship, there will be a sudden death playoff at the following times, and with conditions determined by the Tournament Match Committee.
 - Senior: After the last competitor finishes their round.
 - Ladies: After the senior playoff, or if there is no Senior playoff, it will be at the above time.
 - Open: After the last competitor finishes their round.All other ties will be by lot.
- ◆ No motorised carts, or motorbikes to be used unless a medical certificate is produced prior to the Tournament.
- ◆ Please report to the starter, and be ready to tee off, at least 15 minutes before tee time.

Tournament suspension or Cancellation

Will be indicated by Two long blasts on the siren.

Resumption of play will be indicated by two short blasts.

Cancellation of play will be advised by one long siren blast.

If play is discontinued, the hole being played may be

Completed, or balls marked and lifted - RULE 6/8SLOW PLAY

It's better to be just behind the four in front than be just in front of the four behind.

The organising committee is conscious of slow play. Every endeavour will be made to keep slow play to a minimum and the following rule will apply.

Pace of Play: Rule 6-7 will be strictly enforced. Each group must maintain its position on the course with respect to the group preceding them.

Any group with a clear hold in front of them will be considered out of position. Penalties will be issued to individuals in each group who by their pace, contribute to such delay.

Warnings may not be issued prior to penalties Slow players are usually oblivious of their fellow golfers. If a four loses ground, being aware of it and correcting it, is what it's all about. You don't need to rush your

shots, you don't need to run, but you need to move a little more briskly between your shots. If this is done by the four players concerned, you can catch up in sometimes only a few minutes. The main thing is to be aware of the problem

TIME SAVING SUGGESTIONS

Watch where each player's ball lands then walk briskly to your own ball – much time is lost in players leisurely strolling up the fairway.

- ◆ Sometimes it is better not to assist with the search for a mislaid ball until after you have played yourself.
- ◆ Make a preliminary club selection as you approach your ball – reappraise on arrival at the spot.
- ◆ Park your trundler where you are likely to exit from the green.
- ◆ Line up your putt while the others are putting.
- ◆ Walk briskly to the next tee – player with the honour tees off before marking his card.

There is no need to hurry your shot – it's what you do between shots which count.

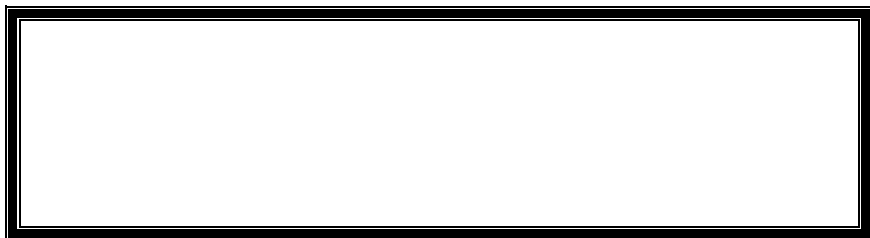
