Membership Project

INTRODUCTION

At the last Board meeting in April at Motueka, our Secretary, Jack Boettcher presented a paper about the need to increase our membership. Subsequently, a sub-committee (Tim Belcher – Vice President, Barry Patton – Delegate for Otago/Southland and Ross Herrett – President) was formed with Tim Belcher to manage the project commencing with a trial in the Wanganui /Manawatu District. Once this initial trial is completed and evaluated, the intention is for your Regional Delegates to roll out the project in their respective regions.

PROJECT GOALS

1. Identify affiliated and non-affiliated Lefties playing at the various courses in each District who are not currently registered with our Association.

2. Once identified and details obtained, communicate the current benefits of membership (which all current members are aware of).

3. Added benefits (available to all) such as monthly countywide competitions using 'dot golf' with cash prizes and perhaps even 'accredited affiliation' through our Association, are in the pipeline.

CONCLUSION

The success of the trial project depends on the goodwill I get from the golf clubs (16) in the Wanganui/Manawatu Region and current members of our Association playing at those clubs. I will let you know how I am getting on in subsequent Newsletters.
