Notes

These accounts have not been audited, the cost of audit increased substantially this year. Our Constitution clause six prescribes that nalgnz Council appoint an Auditor, I am aware of a number of golfing organisations of our size, who get some one with accounting/legal knowledge to attest the accounts for a small return, we may have to deregister as an Incorporated Society to achieve this, and make an amendment to our Constitution, its obvious that as our membership reduces and income, we can ill afford to pay such a sum every year. Regretfully we reflect NZ Golf, many clubs are run by volunteers, and in my estimation, it would be fool hardy to increase subs.

Re accounts 2017 poor weather affected many tournaments and we are grateful to those organisers that sent their Tournament grants back to us. Membership is dropping every year due to member's reaching an age where they can no longer play,

Ill health, and some cases lack of interest, we still have at end of 2017, 470 paid up members, including, life members and a few overseas. This compares very well with most states in Australia, but we need you to support your Local Tournaments, particularly if you cannot support your National Tournament.

There are quite a number of Annual Subscriptions still unpaid, maybe because the last account was close to Christmas and overlooked – those members who are in arrears will receive a reminder notice with this Bulletin. Your attention to this matter will be appreciated.
